## IN THEIR OWN WORDS Get to Know Your WVS Musicians James Benitez, Trumpet



**Tell us about yourself:** My hometown is Phoenix, Arizona and I started playing trumpet when I was 9 years old (4th grade). I also played viola in high school orchestra at Cortez High School (31st Ave & Dunlap), which is part of the Glendale Union High School District. I attended Arizona State University but didn't complete my undergraduate degree because my career in the Phoenix Symphony became too busy. At 18, I went directly from high school into a permanent position with the Phoenix Symphony. I actually trace the beginning of my Phoenix Symphony career to the prior year, when as a 17-year-old high school senior, I performed with the Phoenix Symphony as first-call substitute in the trumpet section. I remained a member of the Phoenix Symphony for 18 years as 2nd Trumpet.

In 1993, I was offered a Principal Trumpet position with the Malmo Symphony Orchestra in Sweden, and I remained in Malmo for two years. In 1995, I became Principal Trumpet with the Norrkoping Symphony Orchestra, in Norrkoping Sweden. During my years in Norrkoping, I would travel to Bergen, Norway to regularly substitute as Principal Trumpet with the Bergen Philharmonic Orchestra. In 1998, I came back to the United States as Co-Principal Trumpet with the Arizona Opera Orchestra which is a position I still hold. In 2007, I became Principal Trumpet with the West Valley Symphony and in 2019, after 12 years as West Valley Symphony Principal Trumpet, I decided to semi-retire and moved myself to the position of Assistant Principal Trumpet. Performing in the 3rd Trumpet position is a good way to semi-retire in these, the twilight years of my career.

My family consists of my wife, Priscilla, with 8 children and 12 grandkids, so far. We'll be celebrating 45 years on our next wedding anniversary. Priscilla also plays with the West Valley Symphony in the violin section. This photo was taken in March 2019, the last time we were able to get everyone together. Priscilla and I are on the far right and she is holding one of our grandsons.
